

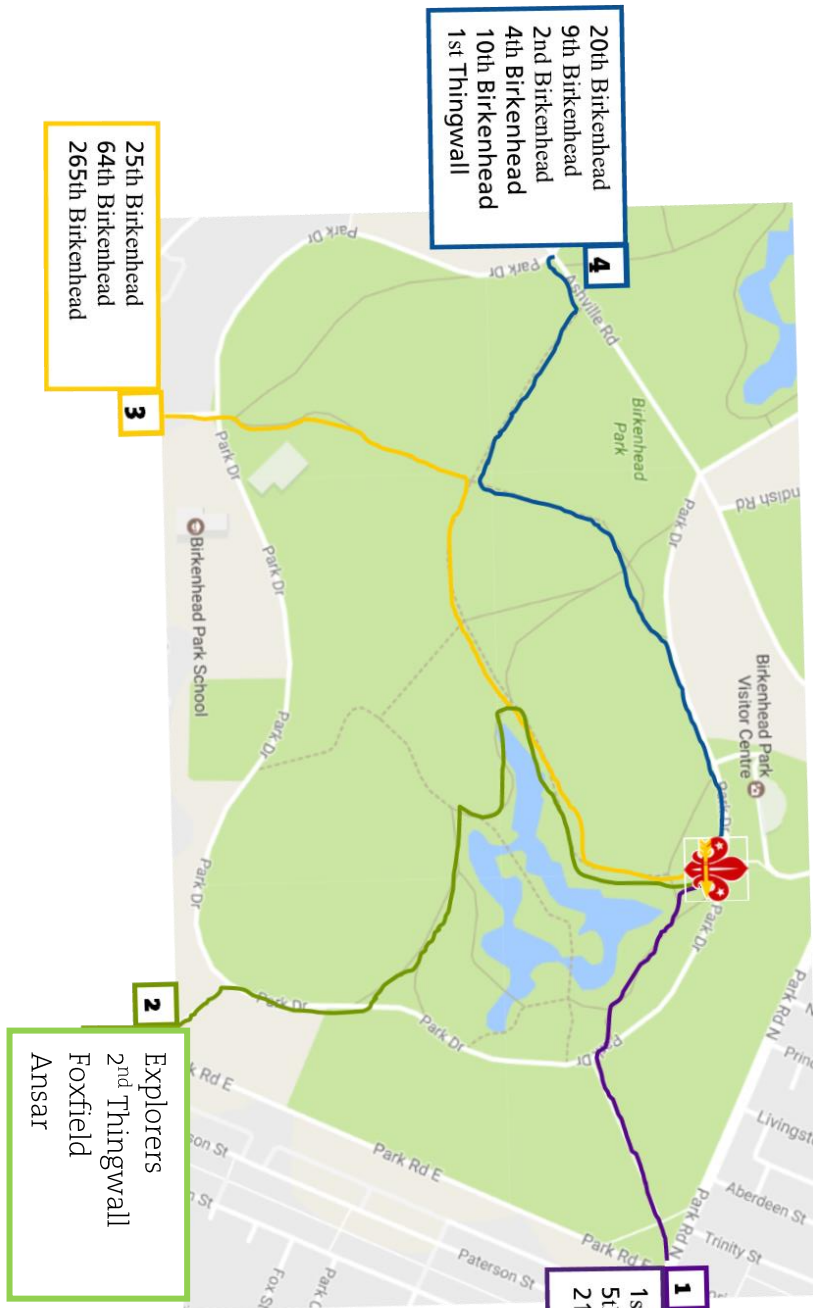
St GEORGE'S DAY CELEBRATIONS
